## 814. COPYRIGHT MATERIAL SOFTWARE

1. Purpose  
P.L. 94-553  
Sec. 107

The Board recognizes that the United States Code makes it illegal for anyone to duplicate copyrighted materials without permission.

2. Authority

The purchaser of a computer program may legally make or have made one (1) copy of that program for archival purposes. Public domain software is copyable without restriction.

The copying of protected software through piracy-aids or other means is in violation of the general educational “fair use” provisions of the copyright law.

No employee shall copy, support or encourage the copying of computer software other than outlined above. A recognized violation of these guidelines will become a matter for administrative action which may include Board review and legal action.
